How to find Skillsoft training in Map My Learning

- Use the Find Learning feature on the landing page. For example, enter "productivity" to view a list of related courses. Or click the "Browse all courses" link.
- On the search results page:
 - To refine the search results, use the Narrow Courses options listed on the left.
 - For specific Skillsoft courses, select "Skillsoft" under Source.
 - Click the course name for additional details on the course contents, available job aids, resources and learning expectations.
